As a result, a student without having any mistake shall suffer irreparably. The University on the basis of registration of students has supplied Pre-Printed Answer Booklet with all details in advance to the College.

Keeping in view the interest and career of student at large, the University intend to regularize the same on receipt of a letter from the Principal containing the following;

1) The student details, College, Centre, Registration Number, Roll Number, Semester, Branch, Subject Name, and Subject Code in Excel Sheet

2) An undertaking by the Principal that the College shall deposit student wise fine as to be decided and communicated by the University.

3) Declaration to the effect that no wrong data or data of un-registered students have been sent to the University.

On, receipt of the same, the University shall electronically de-register, regularize and accordingly shall enable the College to download Admit Card (s) of such Students after 12.00 Mid Night 29.10.2017. Thereafter, the Centre Superintendent shall allow these students to appear at their respective subject (s) in the Un-Coded Answer Booklet and enter their Un-Coded Data in the www.bputodisha.in in Un-Coded Section Module and also provide a separate Sealed Excel Sheet in the Packet to the University.
